BACK TO THE FUTURE: EMPIRES AS SHAPERS OF WORLD ORDER

A CALL TO YOUNG ADULTS TO ENGAGE WITH THE QUESTIONS OF THE FUTURE

What can I do to shape the future of the world? 20 young adults – 10 national and 10 international – aged 18-30 years deal with global issues about the future on three occasions. The format will be led by Herfried Münkler (former professor of political science at the Humboldt University in Berlin) in cooperation with other international experts.

The question of the rise and fall of empires is a highly topical issue, especially against the current backdrop of Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine and the rise of right-wing populist parties in the European Union. The starting point is the renaissance of empires after their supposed disappearance. What does this mean for the present, and how can future perspectives and strategies for a democratic Europe look like?

Different focal points are dealt with in three sessions lasting several days:

The central question of the panel is how a renaissance of empire is to be assessed and evaluated and what dynamics and pressures to adapt will emanate from it in the 21st century.
